

Accordingly, the Commission has decided to extend the concession sought by the said parties under Para 10 to their candidates for the ongoing General Elections, 2014, in the constituencies mentioned as under:-



Accordingly, the candidates set up by the above mentioned recognized political parties at the ongoing General election to the Lok Sabha and/or Legislative Assemblies from the Parliamentary and/or Assembly Constituencies indicated against their name, shall be allotted the symbol, as indicated against their name. The Returning Officers may be informed that the candidates set up by the above mentioned recognized political parties are eligible for the allotment of their respective symbols under paragraph 10 of the Symbols Order, 1968 subject to strict fulfillment of each of the provisions of paragraph 13 thereof.
- 3. It may be noted that the design of the Symbols 'Book' (reserved symbol of National People's Party) and the Symbol 'Ladder' (Reserved symbol of Indian Union Muslim League) has been slightly modified recently on the request of these Parties. Therefore, the modified version of the design should be used for printing the ballot paper wherever the said symbols are being allotted.
